- 2) Generating a map of secondary schools within Kirinyaga County to approach for Sexual, Reproductive Health Rights (SRHR) training;
- 3) Monitoring the progress of existing peer-support groups by attending meetings and reporting feedback delivered by attendees;
- 4) Utilizing the established network to assemble more peer-support groups within neighboring villages to meet the yearly target;
- 5) Increase the activity on our Twitter and Instagram social media profiles by following stakeholders, consistently uploading engaging post and using social media tools that followers will find interesting;
- 6) Liaising with staff internally to ensure that our profiles and documentation is accurate and up-to-date;
